WEATHER PREPAREDNESS

Before the storm, it is important to ensure preparations are made for your family, home, and vehicles.

Prepare Your Home

- Flashlight & Extra Batteries
- Extra Food and Water
- Extra Baby Supplies Diapers and Formula
- Extra Pet Food
- Extra Prescription Medication
- First Aid Supplies
- Cell Phone Charger
- Flashlight
- · First Aid Kit
- Extra Hats, Mittens, Boots, Warm Clothes

In the Event Your Heat Goes Out

- Call in a service request to your property management team
- Close off unneeded rooms to avoid wasting heat
- Use towels or rags to close off any cracks under your doors
- Close blinds or curtains to keep in some heat
- Eat and stay hydrated, drinking plenty of water to prevent dehydration.
- Wear layers of loose fitting, warm clothing. Remove layers as needed to avoid overheating, perspiration, and subsequent chill.

Prepare Your Vehicles

- Full Tank of Gas
- Cell Phone Charger
- Jumper Cables, Flares, Sand/Kitty Litter, Tow Rope
- Snow Brush and Shovel
- Flashlight
- Water/Snacks
- Hats, Mittens, Boots, Warm Clothes, Blankets
